BY-LAWS

Granite State Physicians for a National Health Program

BY-LAWS PNHP CHAPTER: Granite State

ADOPTED: February 21, 2008, Amended September 27, 2017

Article I Name, Objectives, and Fiscal Year

Section 1.1 The name of this organization shall be Physicians for a National Health Program, The Granite State Chapter, known

also as Granite State Physicians for a National Health Program.

Section 1.2 The organization shall act exclusively as a charitable,

educational and scientific research and public education organization within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Federal tax code, and shall operate within activity supervision and reporting guidelines of the national organization as contained in the national organization's corporate articles of organization, bylaws and any affiliation agreement between the chapter and the national

organization.

Section 1.3 The chief purpose of the organization shall be identical to

that of the' national 'organization, Physicians for a
National Health Program, Inc., namely to promote
universal access to health care with no financial barriers to
care. The organization will promote discussion about
health-policy reform and engage in other charitable and
educational tax-exempt activities with the scope of objectives

of the national organization.

Section 1.4 The fiscal year of the organization shall extend from

January 1 to December 31.

Article II Membership

Membership shall be open to all doctors of medicine, osteopathy and dentistry, and students and residents of those disciplines and other concerned health professionals and individuals who support the purposes of the organization; members shall live or work in New Hampshire.

Section 2.2 The privilege of voting shall be reserved for those members who have paid dues to the National PNHP

Article III Governance

Section 3.1 A Steering Committee shall be elected by a majority of the members who attend an annual meeting.

Section 3.2 The Steering Committee shall consist of up to 5 members who agree to attend regular meetings (telephone attendance is included).

Section 3.3 The Steering Committee shall designate a member of the Committee to function as the Convener,

Section 3.4 The Steering Committee shall be empowered to make decisions regarding policy, finances and other related decisions on behalf of the members on matters requiring action.

Meetings Article IV Section 4.1 Meetings are open to the public Section 4.2 Meetings will be held on a schedule determined by the Steering Committee. Section 4.3 The steering committee may call meetings which are closed to nonmembers. The steering committee may also call meetings limited to the steering committee.
